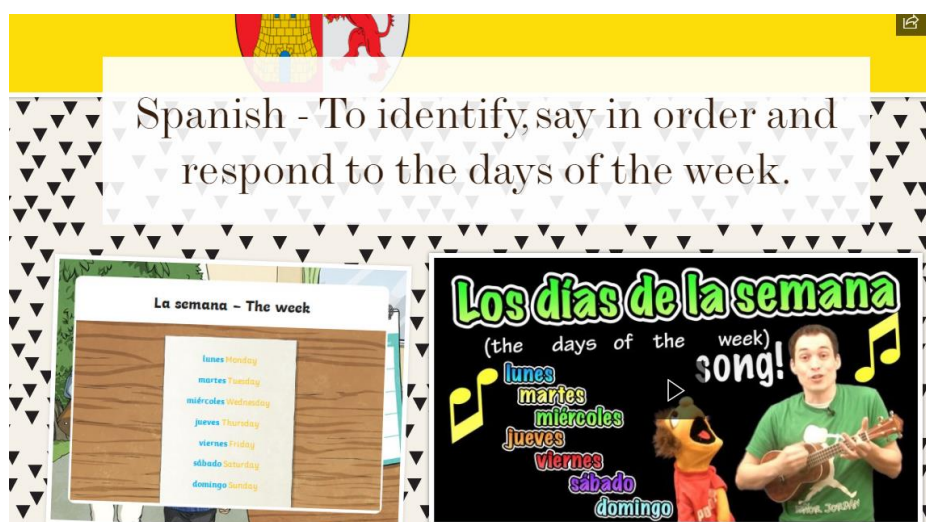


Spanish Subject Leader Report – 2020-21

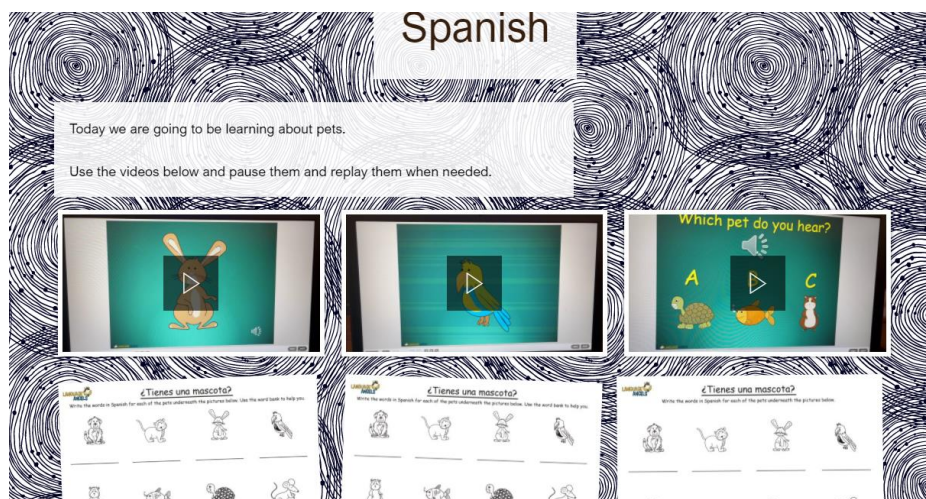
This year has been different due to the Covid-19 pandemic, however Spanish has still been taught across KS2. When in school this year, children from Years 3 to 6 received timetabled Spanish lessons in which they practised the skills, concepts and vocabulary in order to meet the expectations of the Languages National Curriculum. We have continued to follow the Language Angels curriculum covering topics such as: numbers, colours, food, family and school. There are lesson resources for all year groups, including PowerPoints showing recorded pronunciations of key words and during remote learning, teachers taught the lessons online and games were available for children to play.



Remote learning lessons covered many different topics. In Y3 children learnt about time and days of the week. They enjoyed joining in with the song about the days of the week.



In Y4, children learnt about pets and were able to talk about the pets they had.



Children in Y5 learnt about school and what equipment they used.



This lesson teaches us how to say, read and write 10 typical school subjects with a focus on the use of the correct gender. There are plenty of extra worksheet activities for you too.
