

Primary colours

Secondary colours

Warm/Cool colours

Tint

Shade

Geometric shape

Organic shape

Yellow, red and blue. These colours cannot be mixed from other colours. Two of them can be mixed to make secondary colours

Green, orange and purple. These colours are mixed by combining two primary colours

Yellow, orange and red are warm colours. These colours create a warm mood. Blue, green and grey are cool colours. These colours create a cold mood

When a colour is made lighter by adding white, e.g. a tint of blue (light blue)

When a colour is **made darker** by adding black, e.g. a shade of blue (dark blue)

Shapes we can name, e.g. square, rectangle, triangle, circle

A shape we cannot give a name to, unlike a geometric shape. These shapes are often found in the natural world
