A **rough drawing or painting**, possibly to be looked at to be able to complete a finished drawing or painting

The strength, heaviness or darkness of a line

A line which does not end. It keeps going

Where an artist shows in a drawing or painting that an object is **3d rather than flat** or 2d

Where an artist has created an **image on a block**, put paint or ink on the block and then placed paper on top of the block. The image on the paper is the print

Where a print is made by carving lines in a block of wood
